- GOAL # 1: To build a connected PK-12 curriculum that is standards based, clearly articulated for implementation among all schools and across all grade levels, and provides for the academic growth of all students;
- GOAL # 2: To develop a system to closely monitor individual student achievement PK-12 via regular formative and standardized assessments in order to create specific learning profiles on which interventions, supports and extended learning opportunities can be based;
- GOAL # 3: To develop a comprehensive professional learning program connected to district, state and national standards for all district employees, and framed six to 12 months in advance so as to fully impact student achievement;
- GOAL # 4: To increase student achievement overall while narrowing the gaps among groups of students, especially students of poverty and students of color when compared to aggregate or majority achievement.
